**2022 Board of Regents Nominations
Process and Timeline**

TIMEFRAME	ACTION
Late August	Nominations Subcommittee reviews open positions, competencies, application process and schedule.
Mid-September (Open for 4+ weeks)	Announce and open call for nominations (open for ~30 days)
Mid-October	Close call for nominations (allow for one week extension, if needed, and time to gather information on nominated candidates vs. self-nomination.)
Early November	Staff compiles nominations for review and circulates to Nominations Subcommittee.
Mid-November	Nominations Subcommittee meets to review nominees and select the slate of candidates.
Late November	All candidates (selected and not) are notified of the pending slate and made aware of dates for Townhall.
Last week of November	Slate presented to Board (FYI).
Mid-December	Conduct membership townhall to introduce the slate.
Mid-December (Open for 4 weeks)	Voting opens – membership votes on the slate
Mid-January	Voting closes and results compiled.
Mid-January (Opens within 2 weeks of slate voting closing)	*Nomination period opens for individual nominations – if slate does not pass.
Early February (Open for 3 weeks)	*Nomination period closes for individual nominations – if slate does not pass.
Early February (Open for 4 weeks)	*Voting for individual candidates opens – if slate does not pass.
Early March	*Voting closes and results compiled for individual nominations – if slate does not pass.
Mid- to Late-March	Candidates introduced during the annual membership meeting at PM23.
Late March	Candidates assume office following PM23.
